



Contact Lens Evaluation and Management Fee

A complete eye examination as defined by the Optometric Association and insurance companies includes a refraction to assess the need for corrective lenses, and eye health examination including a glaucoma test and a dilated retinal examination where indicated. However, it does not include an assessments of the impact of contact lens wear, measurements or fittings of contact lenses, progress evaluations, training, or ongoing management of care for contact lens patients.

The contact lens evaluation and management fee is a separate professional fee from the comprehensive eye examination fee. Unless a contact lens examination coverage is specifically noted in your insurance plan, your insurance will not pay for this fee and you are responsible for the fee at the time of service. If you do not carry any vision insurance, you will be responsible for the professional fee at the time of service. Contact lenses will not be ordered or dispensed until this fee has been paid.

The contact lens evaluation and management professional fee includes contact lens measurements, fitting evaluations, progress evaluations and patient training.
